#### Last Game

The T-Bones extended their franchise record long winning streak to 11 games with a sweep of the three-game series with the Texas AirHogs. Tommy Collier allowed just one run over seven innings to pick up his eighth win and KC scored four in the sixth to lead 6-1 after six. Texas would cut it down to a 6-4 lead in the eighth but a solo home run from Christian Correa in the ninth and a scoreless ninth for Carlos Diaz who picked up his 11th save was enough to get the win. Daniel Nava and Roy Morales each had a pair of hits and drove in two runs each for Kansas City.

#### Today

The T-Bones continue a key six game road trip with the first game of a three game series against the Sioux City Explorers in Sioux City, Iowa.

#### Pitching Matchup

RHP Jon Perrin will make the start for the T-Bones. Jon Perrin hails from the Kansas City metro area having lettered two years at Olathe East High School before playing college ball in the Big 12 at Oklahoma State University. He was drafted twice while with the Cowboys signing as the 27th round pick by the Milwaukee Brewers in 2015. Perrin spent parts of four season with the Brewers organization before being traded to the Kansas City Royals in 2018. He spent one season with KC pitching at AA Northwest Arkansas. Perrin reached AAA Colorado Springs prior to the trade in 2018. RHP Pete Tago was the first-round draft pick by the Colorado Rockies in 2010 out of Dana Point High School in Dana Point, California. Tago spent his first three pro seasons as a starter before transitioning to the bullpen in 2014. The 26-year-old flourished in the relief role, going a combined 9-8 with a 3.27 ERA, 26 saves, and 199 strike outs in 165.0 innings between 2015-17 in the Chicago White Sox and Mariners farm systems, mostly at the Double-A level. The eighth-year pro was taken in the first round after being named Powerade Player of the Year, First Team All-State, and All-American in high school. He was the 13th ranked prep prospect in the Class of 2010 and had committed to Cal State Fullerton before signing with the Rockies

#### Up next

Following the series with Sioux City the T-Bones return home to face Lincoln for four games with Wednesday the 21st a double header to make up a rain out back on May 22nd. KC will return to Sioux City for the team's second visit to lowa this month following the Lincoln series.

#### Ouch...that will leave a mark!

The T-Bones lead the league in hitting batters from the mound. The club leads the circuit with 65 hit by pitches. Last season the team was tied for second most in the AA with 68. The batters have been hit 37times this season after being hit only 45 times all last season and this season are 7<sup>th</sup>.

#### High water mark

The T-Bones are on a season high 11-game winning streak and are a season high nine games above .500.

## Roster moves

The T-Bones signed RHP Akeem Bostick and traded OF Tyler Marincov to Winnipeg for a player to be named later on Friday morning. Bostick got the win last night in game 1. Then later in the day Friday Kansas City added OF/IF Will Baker a rookie out of Ball State and a native of Lee's Summit and RHP Andrew DiPiazza another rookie who will work out of the KC pen.

#### All- Time Vs. Sioux City

Overall KC is 38-44 against Sioux City. Last season the T-Bones were 7-8 against Sioux City going 4-3 at home and 3-5 on the road. The T-Bones and X's played a thrilling nip and tuck American Association Division series with KC winning the best of five game series on the road at Sioux City.

#### "We are going to the quad"

Kansas City is on a 11-game winning streak a franchise best. The T-Bones won nine in a row twice once in 2004 from August 21 to August 31 and the second last June from the 18<sup>th</sup> through the 28<sup>th</sup>. Those two streaks were the franchise longest with eight being achieved three times. It is the second longest streak in the league this season behind the Sioux City Explorers who won 12 from July 19<sup>th</sup> – July 31<sup>st</sup>. Fargo-Moorhead won 10 from June 18<sup>th</sup> – June 27<sup>th</sup> earlier this season and KC past that streak with the win last night.

#### Deep and deeper

Shawn O'Malley hit two home runs Wednesday night against Cleburne. He added another Friday night in game one. He joins Dylan Tice who had a two long ball night on July 29<sup>th</sup> at St. Paul. Mason Davis had a two-home run game last season on 7/17/18 at Cleburne, while last season he was joined by Zach Walters who hit two vs. Chicago on 5/25/19 in the Dogs first regular season home game in their history and Noah Perio Jr. who went deep twice in a game a pair of times. The first was on 8/16/18 against Fargo and the second to time on 8/24 against Winnipeg. O'Malley has 10 RBI in his last 10 games.

### Quality

The T-Bones Dylan Baker has tossed three straight quality starts of three earned runs or less while pitching at least six innings. This last time through the rotation he was joined by Tommy Collier, Jon Perrin and Christian Binford. Perrin has tossed two in a row vs. Cleburne and with Collier Saturday night and Jose Mesa Jr on Friday night in game two the club has tossed five of their last six. The only non-quality start was a five inning shutout performance from newly signed Akeem Bostick on Friday night in game one.

# Knippschild Stellar as T-Bones Earn Series Victory

Ryan Knippschild (9-6) surrendered one run on three hits over seven innings, and the Kansas City T-Bones (47-34) hit three home runs en route to a 5-1 win over the Winnipeg Goldeyes (40-41) Wednesday night at CommunityAmerica Ballpark.

In front of 3,603 fans, Knippschild surrendered the lone run on a home run by Luis Alen to begin the second inning. Following the home run he did not allow a runner past second base, and at one point retired 13 in-a-row. He struck out eight while walking one to become the third T-Bones pitcher to earn nine wins this season.

Kansas City opened the scoring off Chris Salamida (9-7) when Jacob Blackwood hit his third home run in two games, a solo shot in the first inning, to give the T-Bones the early lead. The home run pushed Blackwood's league-leading total to 28, putting him five long balls from tying the Northern League single-season record of 33.

After Alen's home run tied the game in the top of the second, an RBI single by Jimmy Mojica plated a run in the bottom half, reclaiming the lead for Kansas City.

Rico Washington hit a solo home run in the third to push the score to 3-1 before Ray Sadler hit a home run to start the T-Bones half of the sixth, marking the final run Salamida surrendered in the contest. Salamida allowed four runs on seven hits, striking out three in the loss.

The T-Bones capped the scoring at 5-1 in the seventh when a sacrifice fly by Blackwood off Chad Benefield plated Keanon Simon.

Steven Stewart threw a scoreless eighth, and Erik Hamren worked a perfect ninth for Kansas City. Their three home runs as a team pushed the T-Bones now league-record season total to 130.
