

T-BONES HOST FAMILY PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The Kansas City T-Bones needs local fans and families to become a major part of our team for the 2019 baseball season. If you and your family would enjoy getting to personally know our players and live within 20-25 minutes from the ballpark, then our Host Family program might be perfect for you. Bringing a player into your home will allow for an up close and personal experience with a professional athlete and can be a rewarding experience. Players arrive at the beginning of May for Spring Training and unless released or traded, most will remain into the first of September.

WHAT DO OUR PLAYERS NEED?

His own room, preferably his own bathroom, and access to a laundry room and kitchen. Keep in mind they are mostly "big" guys, so a twin bed may not work. Wifi in the home is needed, as they communicate with their families via wifi.

The host family is not required to cook for their player. The players will be provided dinner at the ballpark after each home game. However, some meals will most likely need to be provided and access to the kitchen will be necessary.

Most players will have their own car, but for players without a vehicle, it is not the responsibility of the host family to provide transportation.

They will have irregular schedules and may be coming home at late hours and sleeping in. Providing the player(s) with a way into your home (key, garage code, etc.) is important.

Players need a safe, comfortable place to call home in a strange city.
