### Last Game

The T-Bones dropped the suspended game from Wednesday 11-4 but won the regular scheduled game 7-3 to take the series three games to one. In game two the T-Bones chased lefty Luke Westphal early grabbing the lead in the first 2-0. Kenny Koplove worked five strong innings and the bats once again in a win helped seal the deal. Nick Lee struck out the side in the sixth and Carlos Diaz worked a scoreless seventh to notch the win for KC.

### Tonight

The T-Bones continue the seven-game road trip through Chicagoland. KC moves to the south side to face the Gary SouthShore RailCats in the first game of a three-game series.

### Pitching Matchups

**Henry Owens** is a left-hander out of Southern California who makes his second start for KC. He joined the T-Bones on June 11th. The Boston Red Sox selected Owens in the first round (36th overall) of the 2011 MLB Draft and he made his professional debut in 2012 with the Greenville Drive of the Class A South Atlantic League (SAL). Owens climbed the system eventually being promoted to the Major Leagues on August 4th, 2015. He made his debut by striking out the first batter he faced in the game, Jacoby Ellsbury and went on to allow three runs in five innings to take the loss against the New York Yankees. He spent parts of two seasons in the Big Leagues in 2015 and 2016 with a 4-6 record and a 5.19 ERA in 85.0 innings. He was claimed off waivers by Arizona in 2017 and the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2018. He was released and resigned by Arizona in 2018 and was released from their organization in March 2019.

**RHP Justin Sinibaldi** is a native of Kenner, Louisiana and played collegiately at Nicholls State ((Thibodaux, LA). He spent three seasons with Lake Erie in the Frontier League before joining Gary this season. He is a career 25-21 with a 3.20 ERA.

### About the RailCats

The Gary SouthShore RailCats and the T-Bones rivalry goes back to the old Northern League. KC is 37-52 in the AA vs. the RailCats since 2011. The RailCats are led by Manager Greg Tagert one of the most successful Managers in all of baseball. In 15 seasons at the helm of the Cats. Tagert has reached the post season nine times. This season Gary is 3-0 after sweeping KC in early June at T-Bones Stadium.

### K Kings

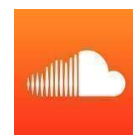

### At the plate

-**Christian Correa** went 2-for-5 with 2 RBI at Chicago. Has reached base in 17 straight games.

-**Ramsey Romano** went 2-for-8 in Chicago with an RBI.

-**Roy Morales** on a five game hitting streak and went 3-for-10 and an RBI at Chicago. He had the game winning walk off RBI Friday night June 21<sup>st</sup> over Cleburne. He was 7-for-12 in the series at Cleburne May 11-13 with 4 RBI. He posted the first 4 RBI for the T-Bones Friday June 14<sup>th</sup> at Texas. He went 11-of-24 on the last road trip.

-**Casey Gillaspie** is on a 10-game hitting streak and is 15 for his last 37. Was 4-for-16 at Chicago driving in six with two home runs. He has three home runs in his last five games. He was 4-for-8 against Sioux City with a pair of walks and three RBI. He had the first four hit night for KC June 14<sup>th</sup> at Texas. It was the first time a T-Bones had had four since Ryan Brett had four on 9/11/18 at St. Paul.

-**Dylan Tice** five game hitting streak. He went 7-for-19 at Chicago with five runs scored and two stolen bases. He had his third three hit game of the season Monday night at Chicago and is 12 for his last 29 in his last seven games. He scored nine runs on the homestand and scored four runs Friday the 21<sup>st</sup> the second time he has done that in his last 11 games while going 2-for-4. He has reached base in 10 straight games. He scored four runs Friday night the 14<sup>th</sup> at Texas the first time a T-Bone has done that in 2019 and the highest total since August 2018. In the Texas series he went 5-for-11 scoring seven runs.

-**Daniel Nava** was 2-for-7 at Chicago with three walks.

-**Forrest Allday** 2-for-8 at Chicago

-**Danny Mars** went 6-for-19 at Chicago scoring four runs. Went 6-for-15 against Cleburne with all three games two hit games. He was 11-for-27 with 8 RBI on the last road trip and has 14 RBI in 19 games with KC.

### Ka'aihue's Blast Caps Off 11-Inning Victory Over Goldeyes

6/28/2011

Kala Ka'aihue connected for a solo home run in the bottom of the 11th inning to send the Kansas City T-Bones (18-25) home with an 8-7 victory over the Winnipeg Goldeyes (25-18) in front of 5,016 fans on Tuesday night.

Ka'aihue connected for his fifth home run of the season with one out and a 2-2 count against Winnipeg right-hander Jamie Vermilyea (1-2). Ka'aihue finished one-for-four with two RBI in the contest. Vermilyea took the loss after allowing two runs on three hits over two and one-thirds innings of relief.

Kansas City took a 2-0 lead against starter Isaac Hess in the bottom of the fourth, scoring the first on an RBI double by Jimmy Mojica. A sacrifice fly by Ka'aihue later drove in Mojica for the second run. Winnipeg answered with five runs in the top of the fifth, sending 10 batters to the plate against T-Bones starter Kris Johnson. A two-run triple by former T-Bone Brian Joynt and a two-run home run from Brian Myrow highlighted the scoring.

The T-Bones later tied the game with a two-run seventh and took a 6-5 lead in the bottom of the eighth. The Goldeyes collected two runs in the top of the ninth against closer Andy Shipman (1-2), including a go-ahead solo blast by Myrow that re-claimed the lead for Winnipeg. Shipman suffered his third blown save of the season, but held on for the victory after allowing two runs on three hits while striking out four in three innings of relief.

Kansas City tied the game at seven in the bottom of the ninth when Mojica opened the frame with a triple and scored on an RBI double by Rico Washington. Mojica fell a home run shy of the cycle, going three-for-five with an RBI in the contest. He was hit by a pitch in the 10th inning, pushing his season total to a team record-tying 14. He also committed a team record five errors in the game.

Washington went two-for-five with two doubles and two RBI to extend his hit streak to 11 games. He has now driven in at least one run in six straight contests.

Henry Owens is a left-hander out of Southern California. Owens attended Edison High School in Huntington Beach, California. He earned the Cal-Hi Sports Mr. Baseball State Player of the Year Award in 2011, after posting a 12–1 record with a 1.15 earned run average (ERA) and three saves, while striking out 140 batters in 91⅓ innings of work. He also was named a 2011 Louisville Slugger High School All-American and earned 2011 Sunset League Pitcher of the Year honors for the two consecutive years.

The Boston Red Sox selected Owens in the first round (36th overall) of the 2011 MLB Draft. He signed with them on August 15, 2011 for a \$1,500,000 signing bonus. Owens made his professional debut in 2012 with the Greenville Drive of the Class A South Atlantic League (SAL), sporting a 12–5 record and a 4.87 ERA in 23 games, including 130 strikeouts and 47 walks in 101⅓ innings. In addition, he finished fourth in the SAL for the most strikeouts, while tying for fourth in wins.

Entering 2013, Owens was ranked as the eighth best prospect in the Red Sox organization and ranked 77th in the MLB.com Top 100 Prospects list. He was promoted to the Salem Red Sox of the Class A-Advanced Carolina League on April 2. On July 17, he struck out a season-high tying 10 in six innings, while combining with two other pitchers to deliver the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 6–0 win over the Frederick Keys. Overall, he posted an 8–5 record and a 2.92 ERA over 20 starts for Salem, including a hitless streak of 19⅓ innings, gaining a promotion to the Portland Sea Dogs of the Class AA Eastern League on August 1.

With the Sea Dogs, Owens went 3–1 with a 1.78 ERA, striking out 46 in just 30⅓ innings over six starts. He was a Carolina League Mid-Season All-Star, as well as SoxProspects.com 2013 Pitcher of the Year. Additionally, he made the Baseball America Minor League All-Star Team. Owens started the 2014 season by pitching a rain-shortened six-inning no-hitter for the Sea Dogs. Making 20 starts in Portland, Owens compiled a record of 14–4 with three complete games in 121 innings, with 126 strikeouts and an earned run average of 2.60. He was promoted to the Pawtucket Red Sox of the Class AAA International League on August 2, 2014. He was a mid-season and postseason All-Star with Portland as well as Eastern League Pitcher of the Year. Owens was invited to Spring Training with the Red Sox in 2015 but began the season with Pawtucket. He was 3–8 with a 3.16 ERA in 21 AAA starts.

The Red Sox promoted Owens to the major leagues on August 4. He made his debut by striking out the first batter he faced in the game, Jacoby Ellsbury and went on to allow three runs in five innings to take the loss against the New York Yankees. He collected his first MLB win in his second start on August 9 against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park, allowing one run through five innings. He made 11 starts in 2015, with a 4–4 record and 4.57 ERA. He spent most of the 2016 season with Pawtucket, where he was 10–7 with a 3.92 ERA in 24 starts but he also made five starts for the Red Sox in the majors and was 0–2 with a 6.95 ERA in those appearances.
