The T-Bones erased a 1-0 deficit in the third inning but would trail 3-1 after four and never recover dropping the series opener 7-4 to Sioux Falls. The T-Bones walked nine batters in the contest.

Today

The T-Bones continue the road trip with the second game of a six-game road trip with the second game of a three-game series at Sioux Falls. It is KC's only visit to South Dakota this season.

Pitching Matchup

RHP Jose Mesas Jr. makes the start for KC. Mesa was drafted in the 24th round of the 2012 MLB June Amateur Draft by the New York Yankees. Mesa was committed to play baseball at Seminole State College of Florida but chose to sign with the Yankees out of Charles Flanagan High School in Pembroke Pines, Florida. He made his pro debut in 2014 with the Yankees rookie club in the Gulf Coast League where he went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA in nine game appearances. In 2019 he began the season. This season, Mesa returned to AA where he pitched in seven games, striking out 11 in 11.2 innings with a 0-1 record. Mesa is the son of former Major League pitcher Jose Mesa, who played with eight clubs over a 19-year MLB career.

RHP Alex Boshers will make the start for Sioux Falls. The native of Nashville, Tennessee is in his fifth pro season all in indy ball. He began his career with Wichita in 2015 where he spent three seasons. He spent a year with Winnipeg in 2018 and saw action in two games at Maryland in the Atlantic League before the move to Sioux Falls. He is 36-34 in his career with a 4.45 ERA.

Let the Countdown begin

With the win last Friday night Manager Joe Calfapietra now has 997 wins as a manager. He is set to be the next indy manager to 1000 win. St. Paul Manager George Tsamis reached 1,000 career wins back on June 12, 2018. He joined former Fargo boss Doug Simunic, current Gary Manager Greg Tagert and second year Chicago Dogs Manager Butch Hobson in the 1,000-win club in Indy ball. He is 997-847.

Vs. the Canaries

The T-Bones are 33-18 against the Canaries since the two clubs joined the American Association.

The T-Bones lead the league in hitting batters from the mound. The club leads the circuit with 50 hit by pitches. Last season the team was tied for second most in the AA with 68. The batters have been hit 30 times this season after being hit only 45 times all last season tied for 7th.

LHP Nick Lee had his contract purchased by Durango in the AAA Mexican League. That followed a busy Sunday where the T-Bones signed outfielder **Tyler Marincov** and released infielder **Taylor Sparks**. RHP **Kenny Koplove** was placed on the inactive list and will retire from baseball.

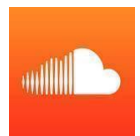
History in Sioux Falls

Professional baseball in Sioux Falls dates back at least to 1902, when the original Canaries joined the Iowa–South Dakota League. That team and its league was short lived as it lasted just two seasons. Another team, known as the "Soos" as well as the Canaries, was a member of the Dakota League from 1920–1923, then moved another short-lived league the Tri-State League in 1924. The longest-lived Canaries prior to the current team were founded in 1933 as part of the Nebraska State League. They joined the Western League in 1939, then joined the original Northern League when the Western League folded after the 1941 season. The Canaries played in the Northern League in 1942 and again from 1946–1953. The city was without a Northern League franchise until 1966. Then the Sioux Falls Packers began play and spent six seasons in the circuit until the league ceased operations following the 1971 campaign.

Lare Brilliant in First Start for Kansas City

07/25/2011

Trent Lare (2-2) gave the Kansas City T-Bones (33-35) seven scoreless innings on Monday night and the bullpen held on for a 4-3 victory over the St. Paul Saints (39-29) in the first game of a three-game set in St. Paul, MN.

Lare, who took the mound for his first start since being acquired in a trade with the Wichita Wingnuts on June 5, baffled the Saints over his seven innings of work. The left-hander struck out three of the first four batters he faced before surrendering an infield single to Richard Mercado in the second. He allowed just three more hits in the outing while the Saints failed to push a runner past first base in the first seven innings of the contest. Lare struck out eight batters overall without surrendering a walk in the victory.

Kansas City used an RBI double by Jeff Hulett to take a 1-0 lead against Alberto Rolon (6-3) in the second inning. The T-Bones added two additional runs in the fourth, scoring the first on an RBI double by Ray Sadler. Sadler later came home on a safety squeeze from Hulett to make the score 3-0. Rolon suffered the loss after allowing three runs on five hits in seven innings for St. Paul.

T.J. Large took over for Lare in the eighth and surrendered a walk and a double while also hitting a batter as the Saints loaded the bases with two out. A groundout by Justin Snyder ended the threat. Kansas City then added a crucial insurance run in the top of the ninth on an RBI double by Gerardo Caceres to gain a 4-0 advantage.

Large remained in the game to start the bottom of the ninth and walked the first batter before a groundout and flyout put a runner on first with two outs. After consecutive RBI doubles pulled St. Paul within two, Andy Shipman took over and surrendered an RBI double to Jonathan Van Every to bring the score to 4-3. Steve Mays then popped out to Shipman to end the contest with the tying run at second.

Shipman picked up his 11th save of the season for Kansas City. Sadler's RBI double in the fourth pushed his season total to a league-leading 77.

Jose Mesa Jr. is the son of major leaguer Jose Mesa, who played with various clubs (Baltimore Orioles, Cleveland Indians, San Francisco Giants, Seattle Mariners, Philadelphia Phillies, Pittsburgh Pirates, Colorado Rockies, Detroit Tigers) from 1987 through 2007. His father was also a pitcher. Mesa Jr. was committed to play baseball at Seminole State College of Florida but was drafted by the New York Yankees out of Charles Flanagan high school in Pembroke Pines, Florida and he opted to sign with the Yankees and start his Major League Baseball career instead. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2012 MLB June Amateur Draft and he did not make it to rookie ball until the 2014 season. In his first season as a professional in 2014, he went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA and in nine game appearances. The highest he made it was Double-A. Mesa Jr. was claimed off of waivers by the Baltimore Orioles. He returned to the Yankees in 2018 after he was designated for assignment by the Orioles.
